- You have streetlights and sidewalks

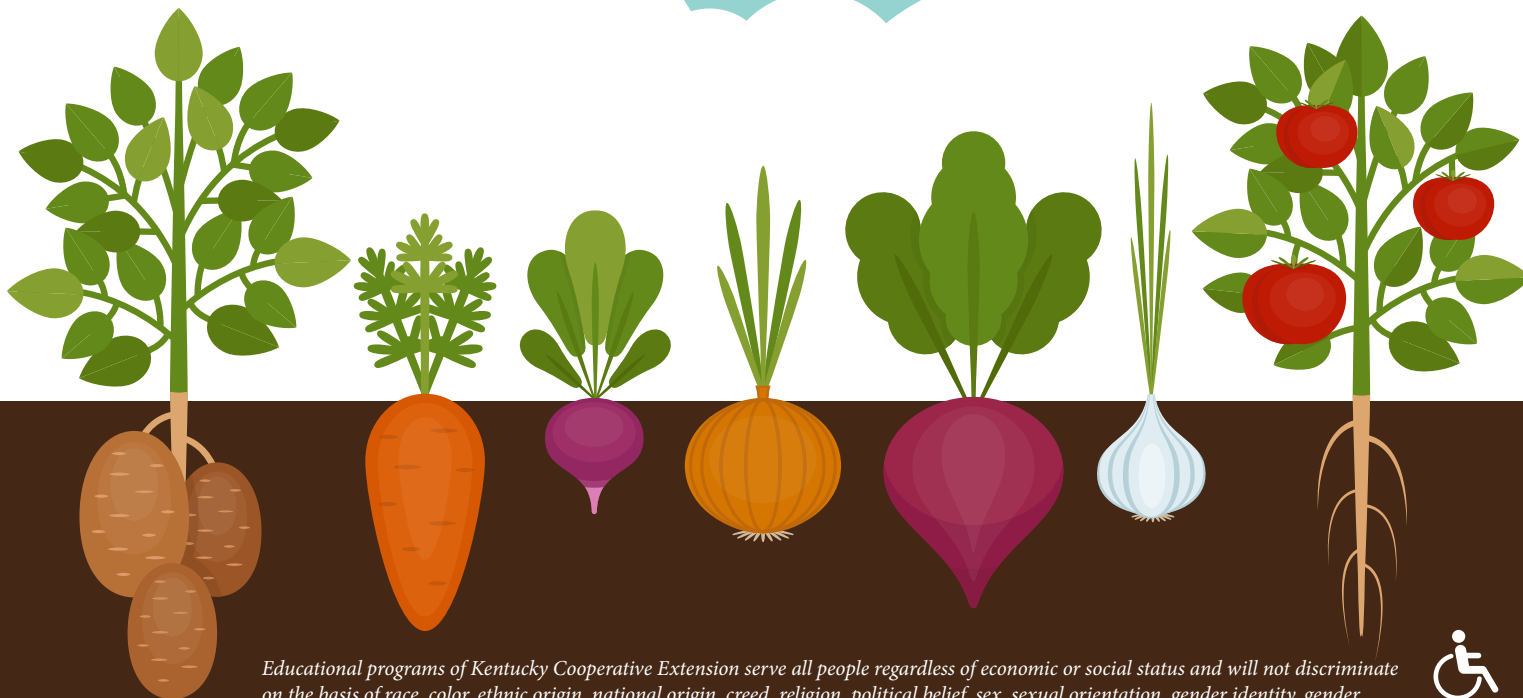
